- Required to submit medical report on tuberculosis -

Effective from 2nd March, 2016, it has been decided by the Ministry of Justice, Republic of Korea that long-term (over 90 days) Visa Applicants are required to submit their medical report on tuberculosis by the specifically designated hospitals as mentioned below.

- A-1, A-2, A-3 category visas are exempt from these rules.
- For D-2, D-4 category visas this rule will be effective from 1st July, 2016
